Reference is made to your original e-mail correspondence received at this office on April 29, 2020, requesting copies of all documents for NYS Police calls to 13590 Duanesburg Road in Delanson, New York, from January 1, 2017 to April 29, 2020, as well as copies of all documents, reports and information pertaining to a house explosion and fire at the aforementioned address on March 8, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Article 6 of the Public Officers Law (Freedom of Information Law).

In accordance with your request and having received your check (#156) in the amount of \$30.00 on February 9, 2021, I have attached copies of two (2) Incident Reports located concerning the above. Please be advised that reductions have been made to prevent an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of those concerned (*Public Officers Law* § 87(2)(b)).

While preparing these records for release, an additional search of our files was conducted and an Incident Report for March 8, 2020 was located, a copy of which is being provided to you. It should be noted that this agency maintains only those records associated with New York State Police arrests and investigations; we do not maintain records of other police agencies in New York State. Pursuant to Public Officers Law § 89(4)(a), any person denied access to a record may appeal that determination within thirty days. Any appeals must be in writing and mailed to the Records Appeal Officer, Administration, at the below address or sent via e-mail to: Foilunit@troopers.ny.gov.
